D. Morris	 Overview of 8/17/22 DEP/LSRPA quarterly meeting. New A901 FAQ posted. LSRPs excluded from needing license (with or without retention form). Nothing posted about emerging contaminates of concern. Administrative Order No. 2022-19 signed by Commissioner LaTourette. SRPLB is now part of the Office of Enforcement Policy. The new Chairperson is Chief Advisor Paul Stofa. SRPLB is still down three people. Technical Consultations: The policy is that it must follow current rules. Remedial Action Permits: Reported there are two primary issues with RAPs: (1) using the wrong forms and (2) details don't match between report and applications. Only 6% of the initial applications were good without additional information. 58% of the initial applications were withdrawn/rejected. Only approximately 20 active Direct Oversight Cases. Did not get great metrics and will report back. LSRPA is preparing e-blasts to get the information out to the members.
