DeLorenzo	<ul> <li>Goal is to expand conference to non-LSRP environmental remediation practitioners</li> <li>Presented goal for estimated revenue, expenses, and net revenue.</li> <li>Will rely on Marketing committee for assistance in messaging and marketing.</li> <li>New - Adding an after lunch AP track of courses for a nominal fee and includes the reception</li> <li>New - Proposal to change pricing structure for the Conference Pass so that the pricing of \$350 includes everything (reception, courses, etc.) This is the average for the last few years for what people have spent. LSRP credits per course would have to be paid.</li> <li>Motion was made to set the conference pass at \$350 and CE certificates at \$50 made by A. Saltzman. R. Ganta seconded. R. Hollender and K.
