







Committee for 2011

 - -Section 3.17: New section allowing for retention of professional staff, including an ED








Key Objectives (continued):


SPRLB Audit Process





- RM&LP Committee has been reviewing common risk related issues for our Member LSRPs.
 - Contracts, insurance and technical/business issues represent some of the highest risks to a practicing LSRP.
 - In 2011, RM&LP has met several times to research these issues to provide guidance to the Membership.
 - Three guidance documents have been developed to assist this effort.




- LSRP Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)
 - Provides some answers to common, everyday questions
 LSRP technical, insurance, procedural, business issues.
 - FAQ first developed in October 2009, but has been updated for final LSRPA BOT approval and posting.
- LSRP "Thoughts to Consider" Contracts
 - Provides helpful contract suggestions from five member firms' LSRP proposal addenda.
 - Series of questions/contract issues w/ example terms which can be included in LSRP contracts.



- RM&LP met internally and with Dan Borgna/Dale Group (w/ Synergy & Ace) to review a potential secondary professional liability insurance product that could be offered to (but not necessarily be endorsed by) the LSRPA Membership.
- John Scagnelli has been instrumental in providing legal perspective on the LSRP contracts and insurance coverage issues with the RM&LP.
- A new guidance document has been developed to assist LSRPs to manage their insurance coverage/risk.



- LSRP "Thoughts to Consider" Insurance
 - Considers insurance coverage issues related to professional LSRP services.
 - Provides a series of questions/issues for a LSRP to review with their employer and/or insurance provider.
- All three guidance documents are undergoing final legal/BOT review and will be posted on the LSRPA website (RM&LP tab) in the next several days.






Monitored Natural Attenuation




RESULTS: TIMESCALE




